- Explore elements of their chosen field with the mentorship of practicing Miami alumni.

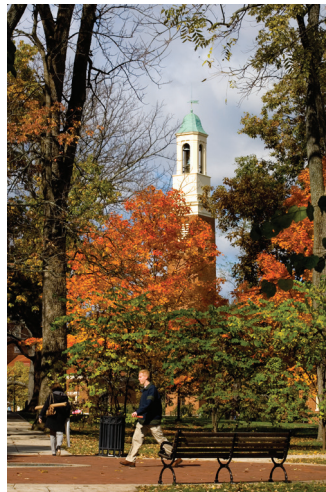
